All professional development courses and many specialization courses require related field experiences. These experiences occur in accredited schools. Individual instructors assign specific course requirements related to field experience. In addition to the professional development courses, courses in early childhood, reading, and special education may also have field experience components. Refer to course descriptions in the university catalog. Field activities are assigned by the course instructor. The College of Education and Psychology Center for Undergraduate Advising and Clinical Experiences in cooperation with participating school districts assigns students to school placements.
